1. Transcript

4. Evaluation

- The evaluation of the student is continuous and carried out through evaluation instruments viz., tests, quizzes, projects, home assignments, case participation and a comprehensive examination.
- The performance in most courses is spelt out in terms of letter grades, A, B, C, D, E. Each letter grade has a qualitative meaning and a grade point value as given below:

- In some courses, descriptive non-letter grades (Excellent; Good; Poor; Unacceptable; Satisfactory(S); Above Average; Average; Below Average; Outstanding; Very Good; Consulting) are awarded which carry no grade points.

5. CGPA

The up-to-date overall performance is reported by the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA), which is a weighted average calculated as below:

$$CGPA = (u_1g_1 + u_2g_2 + u_3g_3 + \dots) / (u_1 + u_2 + u_3 + \dots)$$

where $u_1, u_2, u_3 \dots$ denote units associated with the courses taken by the student and $g_1, g_2, g_3 \dots$ denote grade points of the letter grades awarded in the respective courses, provided that when a student repeats a course, the new grade replaces the earlier one in the calculation of the CGPA.

7. Eligibility Requirement
