♦ If the Korean Ministry of Education adjusts the national tuition policy, the “tuition” stated above may increase by not more than 5%. If these fees are adjusted, you may pay the increase after your arrival in Korea.

\*\*The Korean Government has issued a mandatory national insurance policy for all international students studying in Korea. Each student must enroll in this comprehensive national program and the cost will be approximately 56,000won (\$47)/month (a 50% discount special for students). You will be directed accordingly once you arrive here at the campus.

Notifications:

1. Please ensure that the same amount of **\$4221.50 USD (Fall)** is deposited in the Woosong bank account to be enrolled for the Fall 2022 semester. Applicant is responsible for the remittance charge that occurs when you transfer the fees from the bank in your home country. Another remittance charge is included in the invoice and it is to be deducted by the Korean bank after your fees transferred to Korea. 2. An additional student council membership payment of approximately \$300 is requested upon arrival to cover 3.5 years of departmental activities, such as sports days and university festivals. Students who opt out of payment are not invited to participate.
