THE EXAMINATION

The Indian School Certificate Examination (Class-XII) is in accordance with the 10 plus 2 scheme of school education of the Kothari Education Commission and is taken after a 2-year course of study beyond the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (Class-X) or its equivalent.

MEANING OF GRADES

I. EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

Attainment in a subject is indicated by a grade, of which Grade 1 is the highest and Grade 9 the lowest; only Grades 1 to 8 are recorded on Certificates. The interpretation of the grades is as follows:

II. INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

The standard attained in Socially Useful Productive Work & Community Service, abbreviated on the face of the Certificate as SUPW & COMMUNITY SERVICE, is indicated by a letter grade, of which Grade A is the highest and Grade E the lowest. Only Grades A to D are recorded on Certificates. The interpretation of the grades is as follows:

Awards and conditions for awards:

PASS CERTIFICATES will be awarded to candidates who at one and the same examination attain the pass standard in *four* or more subjects which must include the subject *English*.

Provided that no candidate, except as otherwise exempted by the Council, shall be awarded a Pass Certificate unless in addition to fulfilling the conditions above, the candidate has attained a pass grade in SUPW & COMMUNITY SERVICE as examined / assessed internally by the School.
