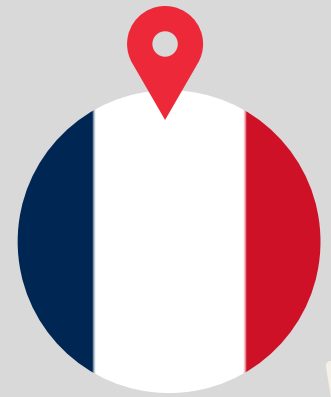

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- For the UG courses, it is required to complete class 12th or an equivalent exam from a recognized board.
- UG Admissions in France required the student to pass the University admission examination from the home country.
- IELTS/ TOEFL marks to the University authorities should be submitted.
- Admissions in the PG Courses required that the candidate must possess the bachelor's degree
- Some universities will provide admission on the basis of the interview level.
- Score cards of GMAT, GRE etc are needed
