Internships

In case a student cannot secure an internship, other modules must be completed to complete the programme.

Student Visa and Immigration Guidelines

All non-EU/EEA nationals are subject to immigration control at the point of entry to the Irish State. EU and United States citizens do not require a student visa to enter Ireland, however please ensure you bring a valid passport, your acceptance letter and proof of payment of fees with you to present to immigration control. Students who require a student visa should apply to the Irish Naturalisation and Immigration Service. Application may take up to 6 weeks to process. Please refer to www.inis.gov.ie for details.

All non-EU/EEA nationals are required to register with the Garda National Immigration Bureau (GNIB) within 30 days of their arrival in Ireland. Before registering with the GNIB, students are required to register with the University and collect a letter confirming their student status from the International Affairs Office at University of Galway, upon registration with the University.

Proof of medical insurance is required for study visa applications and from registering with the GNIB. For further details, please see <https://www.universityofgalway.ie/international-students/offerholders/immigration/>

Estimated Cost of Living

Methods of Payment

International Students can pay their deposit or tuition fee from their home country in one of two ways:

Option 1: TransferMate (Recommended for non-EU Students)

Non-European Union (EU) students are strongly advised to pay their tuition fee through the TransferMate website <https://nuigalway.studentfees.ie/>. TransferMate payments usually take less than 48 hours and the receipt is accepted as proof of payment of tuition fees by the Irish National Immigration Service (INIS) for study visa applications and at the point of entry to Ireland. TransferMate also avoids international bank charges and because you pay in your own currency, the University receives the exact amount owed.

Option 2: Bank Transfer

Alternatively, international students can also pay their tuition fee by international bank transfer using the following details:
