Congratulations on your offer of admission into the Bachelor of Business Administration (Project Management) program, January 2021 term at Yorkville University, Ontario campus.

The payment deadline for your tuition deposit is 20 days from receipt of this letter. Students who submit a deposit within 20 days from the receipt of this preliminary letter of admission secure a seat in the program. If you fail to pay a deposit within 20 days of the receipt of this letter, you may be asked to re-apply or be placed on a waitlist without a guarantee of enrolment.

All students applying to Yorkville University are required to pay their tuition deposit through the ApplyBoard payment portal. Please make your payment by clicking [here](#).

By paying your tuition deposit through the ApplyBoard Payment Portal, you are eligible for a \$10,000 bursary, which will be applied to your tuition account on a pro-rated per course basis. Please review the following page for the sample tuition schedule for students receiving a \$10,000 bursary. Students with transfer credits will receive a prorated bursary amount distributed across their remaining courses.

By paying your tuition deposit through the ApplyBoard Payment Portal (either directly by yourself, or by a third party such as an education agent), you accept and agree to ApplyBoard's terms and conditions:

- An ApplyBoard Service Fee will be applied when you pay through the portal. The total amount of tuition withheld by ApplyBoard as the ApplyBoard Service Fee for the BBA is **\$5,750**.
- This service fee is non-refundable but will be applied to the student's third term of tuition upon successful completion of the first eight weeks of that term.
- Students who receive a study permit and withdraw before Thursday of week eight of their third term of study at Yorkville University will forfeit the \$500 Yorkville University application fee and ApplyBoard Service Fee (as listed above).
- Students who are unsuccessful in obtaining a study permit are refunded their entire tuition deposit payment less Yorkville University's \$500 application fee. Proof of a study permit refusal is required before this refund will be issued. Study permit refusal documents may be verified with Canadian authorities before the processing of refunds.

When you submit your tuition deposit, you will receive a receipt and official acceptance letter. These documents are required as part of your study visa application to Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). Yorkville University will contact you in advance of your start date and will provide a link to your New Student Registration Form as well as your Plan of Study. All international students who study on campus are required to enroll in a health insurance plan through Yorkville University.

The costs mentioned above do not include other fees such as books, expendable supplies, health insurance or cost of living. All fees and charges are quoted in Canadian dollars (CAD).



Other Expenses

The following are estimated living costs in the city of Toronto. These costs are only approximations and intended to be used as a guideline for budgeting your living expenses while studying at Yorkville University.

Groceries	\$100 CAD / week	Varies by personal needs.
Eating out / Delivery	\$40 - \$100 CAD /month	Varies by personal needs. You may want to cook at home to save money

Health Insurance - MANDATORY	\$602 per year (www.inglestudents.com/yorkvilleu)	All international students who study on campus are required to enroll in a health insurance plan through Yorkville University.

Yorkville University ESL Pathway Program

Students wishing to enter Yorkville University whose IELTS score falls below 6.5 may enter Yorkville University under the following conditions:

- Students whose IELTS score (or equivalent) is lower than 4.0 will have to successfully complete Beginner, Level 1 and Level 2 of the ESL Pathway Program.
- Students whose IELTS score (or equivalent) is lower than 4.5 but above 4.0 will have to successfully complete Level 1 and Level 2 of the ESL Pathway Program.
- Students whose IELTS score (or equivalent) is 4.5 or higher but lower than 5.5 will have to successfully complete Level 2 of the ESL Pathway Program.
- Students entering Yorkville University with an IELTS score (or equivalent) of 5.5 will enroll in Yorkville University's regular academic program and will enroll in an English for Academic Purposes (EAP) course in Term 1.
- Students entering Yorkville University after completing Level 2 of the ESL Pathway Program will also enroll in the EAP course in Term 1.

Students without an IELTS score will be asked to complete the Oxford Placement Test to determine their placement in either (a) Beginner level, (b) Level 1, (c) Level 2 or (d) the first term of their academic program with a concurrent EAP course. Each level will take one academic term to complete.

All students will have access to on-going language and international student services during their studies at Yorkville University.

The ESL Pathway Program is offered at the Davisville Campus in Toronto.
