Confirmation of acceptance to study (CAS)

Paying the deposit shows your commitment to studying at DMU and helps demonstrate to the visa authorities that you are a committed student.

- You must make a minimum deposit payment of 50% of your first-year tuition fees by 19 December 2025 in order for your place on the course to be confirmed.
- You must meet the conditions of your offer and pay your deposit in order for a CAS to be issued
- You will not be able to register until you have paid 50% of the total tuition fee charged for the first year of your course. Therefore, you must ensure this payment value has been met well before the registration deadline. 50% of your tuition fees is calculated as total fees minus any eligible discount or scholarship divisible by two.
- If you are a sponsored student, you will need to provide evidence from your sponsor on headed paper to show that your tuition fees will be paid.

Please note that there is a possibility deadlines might be brought forwards for some courses based on capacity.

When your CAS is issued to you, you will also be given important information about the visa application process and what you need to be aware of. Student visa guidance can be found at dmu.ac.uk/london/visa-information
