FEES AND LIVING COSTS

The fees for this programme are currently set at £22000 for the Academic year 2021-22. A full list of up-to-date fees can be found [here](#).

This offer is made on the understanding that you qualify as an Overseas student for fees purposes. If you have any questions about your eligibility to pay international fees please contact our [Fees Assessment Officers](#).

We estimate that a single person will need a minimum of £9,207 per year to cover the cost of living on an annual basis. If you are planning to bring your family with you then your living costs will increase. You can find out more about maintenance amounts on our [website](#).

TUITION FEE DEPOSITS

As an overseas applicant for postgraduate taught study, you are required to pay a tuition fee deposit to confirm your intention to study at the University. This is included as a condition of your offer. The deposit amount is £1,000 and it will be deducted from your tuition fee when you register in September.

If a deposit payment is not received by the deadline as quoted in the condition of your offer, your offer will be withdrawn.

You will receive an email from [Flywire](#), the University's approved payment provider. This email will contain instructions on how to activate your account and make a payment. You will need your University reference number, which can be found at the top of your offer email.

If your tuition fees are fully funded by a third-party sponsor (a government sponsor, charity, US Federal Loan, commercial organisation, international organisation) or you have been awarded a full scholarship, you must provide written evidence of this by the deadline or your offer will be withdrawn.

SCHOLARSHIPS

VISAS

Please note that you will need to meet the requirements set by the UK authorities in connection with obtaining a visa for studying in the UK. You can find more information on the UK Visas and Immigration [website](#).

If you are applying for a Student Visa you will be required to pay an [immigration health surcharge](#). All students who apply for a visa will be subject to an additional £470 surcharge per year. This will allow those holding a Student Visa to access the UK's National Health Service (NHS) facilities and receive most treatment for free.

Further pre-arrival advice, including details of your Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS) number, will be sent to you once you have received an unconditional offer.

ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS

The University requires international applicants to provide original academic documents which verify completion of your qualifications. We are required by UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) to check these documents. Documents will be checked and verified when you register at the University in September.
